Stage:

- 1) SPEAKER will require audience access / steps as audience members may participate on stage.
- 2) SPEAKER does not require a Lectern. If one is used for other presenters, it is recommended to be positioned on stage left or right to allow for un-obstructed viewing.
- <u>3)</u> A standard catering tray stand ("Tray Jack") on up-stage left with a covering linen





4) Also, a high-top cocktail table (Preference), with linen opposite tray jack on stage right (no chairs). **OR**, Option 2 - A small sized round or square table with two chairs can also be used.

Audio & Graphics:

- <u>5)</u> SPEAKER travels with Countryman E6 over-ear microphone and necessary adapters to be used with Venue/AV Team provided Shure, Sennheiser and Technica transmitter/bodypack.
- 6) A two button "Perfect Cue" remote is preferred and provided by SPEAKER if needed.
- <u>7)</u> One wireless handheld microphone on stand, up-stage right requested.
- 8) PPT graphics will be used with embedded audio self-cued by SPEAKER. PPT files can be provided onsite, or presenters laptop can be used, please let us know your preference. (Macbook pro USB-C style connectors and power outlet).

**If SPEAKER is providing camera setup described in next section, SPEAKERS laptop will be used.

Live Camera / iMAG:

Jon will use live video for close-up / sleight-of-hand in the presentation.

Option 1: AV/Client provided live Camera or Robo Camera(s) for iMag / live shots.

- 1) Long throw or Lens capable for full body
- Static Close-up Camera capable for tabletop shot. This is a static shot and should not be cut away during routine until finished. A picture in picture is also a great option to keep close-up camera as the primary image and Jon and volunteer as PIP image.

This static cam can be a robocam or with an operator. Here is one example:



Option 2: Speaker Provided Camera If iMAG is NOT being utilized.

- 1) In this scenario PPT graphics and audio will be presented from SPEAKERS laptop located onstage within 20 feet of table.
- <u>2)</u> HDMI, audio and power will be made available to that location. (Speaker does NOT need to access laptop during presentation)
- 3) A "boom" microphone stand seen at right is optimal with threads in place of microphone clip.
- <u>4)</u> Speaker will attach a USB powered HD webcam to laptop and a live camera "Cameo" slide will be inserted. No camera operators needed.



Other:

- <u>1)</u> If a conference bookstore is available to attendees, SPEAKER requests access, or, a table at the back of the room by main exit doors for attendee interaction and display of continued learning materials available.
- 2) Food should not be served or cleared during performance.
